Kidney Dialysis programme

A new initiative to assist Chronic Kidney Disease patients (CKD) needing regular dialysis at times from the private sector due to non-availability of slots in the public hospitals. Each dialysis costs app. LKR 7,000 to 9,000. Contributions received are collected into a pool and disbursed monthly to the patients. CandleAid donates up to LKR 50,000 (the cost of one round of dialysis per month for a period of six months), to be later reviewed on a case-by-case basis. 89 patients have been assisted so far.
